Since 1986 Inner West Community Transport has been providing local residents who are eligible for the service with transport assistance to hospitals, medical centres, social outings and we provide a shopping service to various shopping centres in the Inner West area.

Inner West Community transport caters to clients who speak all languages, with many clients speaking Chinese, Italian, Tamil, Arabic, Polish and up to 40 other languages which reflects the cultural diversity of the area.



Demand for this service is high but costs are kept low because of government funding but mainly because of volunteers!
